

ORDINANCE 2011-17
VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

**AN ORDINANCE TO HIRE A CLERK OF COUNCIL AND DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, is retiring on October 31, 2011;

WHEREAS, the members of Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake deem it necessary and advisable to hire and employ a part time Clerk of Council Clerk, to ensure the continued and effective operation of said Village Council;

WHEREAS, compensation for said Clerk of Council has been appropriated from the general fund of the Village and there are sufficient funds available for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Charter requires public reading of an ordinance to occur on three separate days, unless two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS. BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE:

Section 1. That Valerie Hans is hereby appointed Clerk of Village Council of Buckeye Lake.

Section 2. Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, welfare, and morals, such emergency arising out of the necessity to provide for the continued and effective operation of the Village government; wherefore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
