

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-24

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN ADDITIONAL POSITION OF ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, is currently in need of creating an additional Assistant Fire Chief for the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake deem it necessary and advisable to employ an additional assistant fire chief to address the changing need of the operation of the department; and

WHEREAS funds have been appropriated from the fire levy fund of the Village and there are sufficient funds available for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Charter requires public reading of an ordinance to occur on three separate days, unless three-fourths of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO:

Section I. That an additional position of Assistant Fire Chief is hereby authorized to be created.

Section II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
