

ORDINANCE 2021-02
VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO GRANT A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT OF VILLAGE PROPERTY FOR THE MUNICIPAL BRIDGE PROJECT AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation is working on bridge preservation within the Village, Project Identification (PID) 108770, and known locally as the Municipal Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to grant a permanent right-of-way easement from the Village of Buckeye Lake, Parcel No. 074-342264-00.000, 10900 Hebron Road, for the Municipal Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Mayor to execute such contracts, deeds, and documents necessary to grant said right-of-way easement;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of The Village of Buckeye Lake, at least two-thirds (2/3) of its members concurring to dispense with the requirements of charter section 4.04 requiring three readings on three separate days with at least one week between the readings:

Section I. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to grant a permanent right-of-way easement from the Village of Buckeye Lake property located at 10900 Hebron Road, Parcel 074-342264-00.000, for the Municipal Bridge Project, and to execute any documents necessary for such, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section II. For the reasons in the preamble, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Buckeye Lake. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
