

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-07

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY NECESSARY FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZING THE SAME BE PURCHASED FROM ANOTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WITHOUT BID (PER ORC. §735.053) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio wishes to purchase certain property owned by the City of Whitehall, to wit, a 2016 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, VIN #1FM5K8AT7HGA24060; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle, which has a value of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), is necessary for a municipal purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police with the concurrence of the Council deem it prudent to purchase the same, and

WHEREAS, the City of Whitehall, Ohio desires to sell said vehicle, and

WHEREAS Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract, without advertising or bidding, with the City of Whitehall, Ohio for the purchase of said vehicle, such sale shall be conducted in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the 2016 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, VIN #1FM5K8AT7HGA24060 is necessary for a municipal purpose, and

SECTION 2: That the same shall be purchased in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053, from the City of Whitehall, Ohio, for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), and

SECTION 3: That the Village hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract without advertising or bidding for the purchase of said vehicle and to do such other acts as are necessary to affect the purchase of said property.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public safety and welfare, such emergency being the time period in which the purchase must be completed and the need for the new police cruiser, and therefore, shall take effect and be enforced immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
