## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-29**

## VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 – 2023 PAY PLAN AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend its 2022-2023 pay plan; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has recommended adjustments and changes to the pay plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, at least two-thirds (2/3) of its members concurring to dispense with the requirements of Charter Section 4.04 requiring three readings on three separate days with at least one week between the readings:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That the Village of Buckeye Lake 2022 – 2023 Pay Plan, adopted in Ordinance 2021-70, is hereby amended, as indicated in Exhibit A, attached hereto and such amendments shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.

**SECTION 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of R.C. §121.22.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance, for the reasons in the preamble, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Buckeye Lake, for which reason the Council hereby declare this Ordinance and emergency measure and it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
