AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 – 2025 PAY PLAN AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires to amend its 2024-2025 pay plan; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has recommended the attached changes to the pay plan regarding the changing of the Code Enforcement Officer position from a monthly stipend position to a part-time hourly position at an average of 20 hours per week with a pay range of \$20.50-\$23.50 per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Buckeye Lake 2024 - 2025 Pay Plan, adopted in Ordinance 2023-68, is hereby amended, as indicated in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance, for the reasons in the preamble, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Buckeye Lake in that monies are immediately needed to meet salaries, payroll, and other expenses so that the Village may continue to pay authorized expenditures, the Council hereby declare this Ordinance an emergency measure and it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
