A RESOLUTION DECLARING TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF TEN MILL LIMITATION TO PROVIDE FOR THE CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

THE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1981, AT THE OFFICE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL WITH THE FOLLOW-ING MEMBERS PRESENT:

moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Chio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Chio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Buckeye Lake for the purpose of providing current expenses of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Chio, at a rate not exceeding five mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years.

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a 55% of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Village of Buckeye Lake be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections, Licking County, Ohio, seventy-five days prior to the June Primary Election held on June 2, 1981 and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

RESOLVED, That the question of such levy be submitted to the electors of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, at a Special Election to be held in the usual voting places within said Village on the second day of June, 1981; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the form of the ballots cast at such election shall be:

A fifty-five percent affirmation vote shall be necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Chio, for the purpose of providing for the general operating expenses of the said village at a rate not to exceed 5 mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation which amounts to fifty cents (\$.50) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for each of the years beginning with the current tax year 1981 and continuing for a period of five years.
