As Amended Emergency Legislation. (CESlater)

Whereas litter is unsightly and unsanitary, and,

Whereas millions of dollars are spent in Ohio each year to remove litter from along roads, streets, waterways, recreational places, and other public areas; and,

Whereas the Buckeye Lake Village recognizes the existence of a litter problem within the boundaries of Buckeye Lake and the need to address the problem, at the local level; and,

Whereas the Ohio Litter Control Act of 1980 provides, through the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Litter Control, for the allocation of public funds in the form of grants for the purpose of enhancing local litter control programs; and,

Whereas having reviewed our application for a grant under this program and having considered the guidelines covering the administration and use of such grant funds

Be it resolved that the Buckeye Lake Council

Hereby endorses, and supports a litter control program for the Buckeye Lake Village and is asking the necessary funds to implement said program as indicated in the accompanying application, and,

Hereby authorizes Mayor, Charles E. Slater, to apply for, budget and administer a grant, which if approved will be used to implement and fund said program for the Buckeye Lake Village; and,

Hereby requests the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Litter Control, to consider and approve said application program, said program being in accord with the guidelines governing use and expenditure of said funds.
