A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF A MORAL CLAIM AGAINST THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Mr. ^{William} ~~Robert~~ Martin worked as a ^{de} facto employee of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio for a period of eighteen days during the Mayor's absence; and

WHEREAS, the above individual had been told by officials of the Village of Buckeye Lake that he would be paid for his labor; and

WHEREAS, a salary had not been appropriated for Mr. Martin prior to his employment; and

WHEREAS, a position had not been created prior to his employment; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Martin has submitted a claim to the Village of Buckeye Lake for Four Hundred and Sixty Nine Dollars (\$469.00) for services rendered during said period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, That:

Section 1: The Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake hereby authorizes and directs the Auditor and Treasurer to issue payment in the amount of \$469.00 to Mr. Robert Martin for services rendered, during the Mayor's absence. Said amount shall be paid from the street fund.

Section 2: The Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio recognizes a moral claim that cannot be legally enforced.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
