A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CLERK AND TREASURER TO TAKE APPROPRIATE STEPS TO TRANSFER FOUR THOUSAND THIRTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$4,032.00) RECEIVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO FROM UNION TOWNSHIP, OHIO TO THE BUCKEYE LAKE FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC. *In declaring an Emergency.*

WHEREAS, Four Thousand Thirty-Two Dollars (\$4,032.00) was received by the Village of Buckeye Lake from Union Township; and

WHEREAS, This money represents money generated from a tax levy for fire protection which was in effect in Union Township prior to the separation of the Village from said Township; and

WHEREAS, had there been no separation, said money would have been spent on fire protection by the Township; and

WHEREAS, said money has in the past been part of Buckeye Lake Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, That:

- Section 1: The Clerk and Treasurer are hereby directed by the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio to give Four Thousand Thirty-Two Dollars (\$4,032.00), recently received from Union Township to the Buckeye Lake Volunteer Department, Inc.
- Section 2: This amount is in addition to the contractual amount paid by the Village of Buckeye Lake to the Fire Department for fire protection.
- Section 3: Council has determined that the Buckeye Lake Volunteer Fire Department, Inc., cannot effectively operate and protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Buckeye Lake, Ohio without being in receipt of this money to cover the Fire Departments operating expenses.
- Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period by law.
