

RESOLUTION NUMBER 81-29

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARY OF THE OFFICE OF VILLAGE MARSHALL, HEREBY DESIGNATED AS POLICE CHIEF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The salary for the office of Village Marshall, designated as Chief of Police, is set at the following rates:

From January 1, 1982 through March 31, 1982 at a rate equivalent of \$14,000.00 per annum.

The period from April 1, 1982 through June 30, 1982 at a rate equivalent to \$14,250.00 per annum.

From July 1, 1982 through September 30, 1982 at a rate equivalent to \$14,500.00 per annum.

From October 1, 1982 through December 1, 1982 at a rate equivalent to \$14,750.00 per annum.

From and after January 1, 1983, at a rate equal to \$15,000.00 per annum.

Section 2: Nothing in this Resolution shall be considered to extend or eliminate the probationary period required by the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: The amounts contained herein shall not include pension and disability funds, unemployment compensation, workmans compensation, which the Village is required to pay by law. The amounts do include the employees share of the pension and disability contributions as well as all State, Local and Federal Income Tax contributions.

Section 4: In that it is immediately necessary as of January 1, 1982, to have a Chief of Police for the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio so as to provide police protection to its citizens, an emergency is hereby to exist and this resolution shall take affect immediately after its passage.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force amd take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
