A RESOLUTION REQUESTING AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAINTAIN CERTAIN SPEED ZONES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Buckeye Lake desires to have the currently posted speed limits described below continue in effect rather than have them revert to 55 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish this end it is necessary to petition the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; That:

Section 1: The Director of Transportation is authorized and requested by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake to maintain a 45 mile per hour zone on State Route 79, from log point 2.43 to 2.74 and a 40 mile per hour zone on State Route 360, from log point 0.00 to 0.22. All of the above mentioned portions are within the corporation limits of Buckeye Lake.

Section 2: An emergency is hereby declared to exist in that if the above described zones are permitted to lapse the speed limit will increase significantly thereby creating a risk to life and property within the corporation limits of Buckeye Lake due to the increased speeds on those highways.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
