A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, TO APPLY TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, OHIO LITTER PROGRAM DIVISION FOR A LITTER GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, funds are available from the State of Ohio, Ohio Department of Natural Resources for Villages to implement litter control programs which meet with the approval of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake is desirous of securing funding for litter control programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, That:

- Section 1: The Village Council authorizes the submission of a litter grant to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.
- Section 2: Such grant shall be submitted by the appropriate official of the Village of Buckeye Lake.
- Section 3: In that litter is a blight upon the community and its control is urgently needed for the preservation of property and health, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency and this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
