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RESOLUTION NUMBER 82-23

A RESOLUTION EXPANDING THE DUTIES OF THE DEPUTY CLERK BY DIRECTING THAT THE DEPUTY CLERK WORK UP TO BUT NO MORE THAN THIRTY (30) HOURS PER MONTH AS THE CLERK OF THE MAYOR'S COURT OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE DOLLARS AND 50/100 (\$3.50) PER HOUR FOR THE HOURS WORKED AS DEPUTY CLERK AND MAKING SUCH POSITION RETROACTIVE TO JULY 15, 1982, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village Council has determined that the Village Mayor's Court is required by law to have a Clerk and an individual who shall be responsible for the Traffic Violations Bureau; and

WHEREAS, The current Deputy Clerk of Council has indicated a willingness to take on this added responsibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The Deputy Clerk of the Village of Buckeye Lake is hereby authorized to fill the position of Clerk of the Buckeye Lake Mayor's Court.

Section 2: Council authorizes and directs the Clerk of the Village of Buckeye Lake to compensate the Deputy Clerk at a rate of three dollars and 50/100 (\$3.50) per hour for up to thirty (30) hours per month for the time said Clerk works as Clerk of the Mayor's Court and Clerk in charge of the Traffic Violations Bureau.

Section 3: This resolution is retroactive in nature and shall take effect from and after July 15, 1982. Council recognizes its obligation to compensate the Clerk for work previously done as defacto Clerk of the Mayor's Court and Traffic Violations Bureau.

Section 4: The Deputy Clerk shall keep track of all hours work and certify her hours to the Clerk of Council on a monthly basis.

Section 5: This resolution is declared to be an emergency in that it is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and property of the citizens of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, in that it is necessary to have a Traffic Violations Clerk due to the Rules of Traffic Procedure as promulgated by the Supreme Court of Ohio. As an emergency measure this resolution shall take effect immediately.
