RESOLUTION NUMBER 83-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS TO COMPENSATE THE COUNTY OF LICKING FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN ELIMINATING A LOG JAM ADJACENT TO THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners expended county monies to break-up a log jam which presented a possible risk of flooding to the property and inhabitants of the Village of Buckeye Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is desirous of paying their fair share of the expenses incurred in such project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) is hereby authorized for payment to the County of Licking to compensate the county for expenses previously incurred in breaking-up a log jam in the vicinity of the Village of Buckeye Lake.

Section 2: The Village recognizes this amount as a moral obligation of the Village.

Section 3: This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
