A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE LITTER GRANT FUND.

WHEREAS, due to a cash flow problem in funding the State Litter Grant, Council must transfer money from the General Fund to the Litter Grant Fund to pay the bills of the Litter Grant Program until such time as the General Fund is reimbursed by the grant from the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: Six thousand five hundred forty-three dollars (\$6,543.00) is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the Litter Grant Fund.

Section 2: This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
