

RESOLUTION NUMBER 83-31

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A VILLAGE HALL, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO BE USED AS A VILLAGE HALL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake has previously authorized the sale of \$125,000.00 worth of bond anticipation notes; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the sale of said notes have been deposited in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, Council desires this money to be appropriated for the purpose of purchasing a building to be used for office space for the Village of Buckeye Lake; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that it is necessary to provide offices for the Village of Buckeye Lake so that the needs of its citizens may be better served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: \$125,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund for the purpose of purchasing in part, certain real property to be utilized as a Village Hall.

Section 2: The Clerk of the Village of Buckeye Lake is hereby authorized and directed to purchase the real estate described in Exhibit 1. The Clerk is authorized to spend an amount not exceeding \$140,000.00 for said property. This price shall include the purchase price, conveyance fees, legal fees, title insurance, and other expenses incidental to the purchase and sale of real estate.

Section 3: The Clerk is further authorized to draw upon the revenue sharing account in an amount not to exceed \$16,000.00 to provide the necessary funds needed for the purchase of said real estate.

Section 4: For the reasons mentioned in the preamble which are incorporated hereto in this Section, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
