NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

- Section 1: The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into personal service contracts on behalf of the Village of Buckeye Lake for the following positions:
 - (1) Inspector: Sixteen (16) hours per week at \$7.41 per hour for forty-nine weeks (49) commencing January 23, 1984. Total compensation to be paid pursuant to this position shall not exceed \$5,812.00 during the 1984 fiscal year.
 - (2) Clerk/Typist: Sixteen (16) hours per week at \$3.42 per hour for forty-nine weeks (49) commencing January 23, 1984. Total compensation for this position shall not exceed \$2,688.00 during the 1984 fiscal year.
- Section 2: This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the immediate hiring of the above individuals will help to insure the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Buckeye Lake by the enforcement of the various housing codes. As an emergency measure this resolution shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
