

RESOLUTION NUMBER 84-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE FOR PERSONAL SERVICES CONCERNING THE HOUSING CODE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM GRANT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into personal service contracts on behalf of the Village of Buckeye Lake for the following positions:

(1) Inspector: Sixteen (16) hours per week at \$7.41 per hour for forty-nine weeks (49) commencing January 23, 1984. Total compensation to be paid pursuant to this position shall not exceed \$5,812.00 during the 1984 fiscal year.

(2) Clerk/Typist: Sixteen (16) hours per week at \$3.42 per hour for forty-nine weeks (49) commencing January 23, 1984. Total compensation for this position shall not exceed \$2,688.00 during the 1984 fiscal year.

Section 2: This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the immediate hiring of the above individuals will help to insure the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Buckeye Lake by the enforcement of the various housing codes. As an emergency measure this resolution shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

CONTRACT FOR PERSONAL SERVICES

This Agreement, dated the 7th day of February, 1984, is made by the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as "Village", and Robert Floyd, of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as "Inspector".

In consideration of the mutual promises to each other given, the Village hereby agrees as follows:

(1) To compensate the Inspector at a rate of \$7.41 per hour for forty-nine (49) weeks commencing retroactive to January 23, 1984 and continuing until the sum of \$5,812.00 has been expended by the Village.

(2) The Inspector shall work at least sixteen (16) hours per week, but in no event shall the Inspector be compensated for any weekly period in an amount greater than sixteen (16) hours.

(3) The Village shall also provide to the Inspector, but not for compensation, a Clerk/Typist, supplies and certain equipment with which the Inspector shall perform his duties.

In consideration of the mutual promises to each other given, the Inspector hereby agrees as follows:

(1) The Inspector agrees to perform the duties of Housing Code Enforcement Officer for the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

(2) The Inspector specifically agrees to provide the Council of the Village with monthly reports concerning his duties as Code Enforcement Officer.
