A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND CLERK TO ENTER INTO A PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACT FOR PART-TIME POLICE PROTECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO MONTHS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a special need exists for having a part-time policeman on duty in the Village of Buckeye Lake from September 5, 1984, through November 5, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, Council at this time does not wish to hire a permanent full-time policeman; and,

WHEREAS, a part-time, non-permanent employee will fill the Village needs until November 5, 1984,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, that:

- Section 1: The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Charles Mefenny bidding procedures being waived.
- Section 2: Said contract will last from September 5, 1984, through November 5, 1984, and the contract employee shall, during that period of time, act as a part-time village policeman for the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, under the direction of the Chief of Police and the Mayor.
- Section 3: Said contract employee shall be compensated at a rate not to exceed \$ 5.00 and an amount not to exceed this figure times thirty-five (35) hours per week.
- Section 4: As a part-time, contract employee for a limited period of time, said contract employee shall not receive any of the entitlements due full-time police personnel by virtue of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5: This Resolution shall go into effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law and is an emergency measure necessary to provide adequate police protection to the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.
