A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FOR THE DAILY OPERATION OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, funds must be transferred to the Litter Grant Fund to meet the obligations of the Village relating to the Litter Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village will be reimbursed by the State for the amounts transferred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, that:

Section 1: Three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the Litter Grant Fund.

Section 2: Upon receipt of the three thousand dollar (\$3,000.00) payment from the State, said funds will be deposited within the General Fund of the Village.

Section 3: This Resolution shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
