A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR THE DAILY OPERATION OF THE VILLAGE GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, the Village has not yet received funds from the State of Ohio to pay the Litter Grant Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer funds to meet the payroll obligation of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, that:

Section 1: \$3,000.00 is transferred from the General Fund to the Litter Grant Fund.

Section 2: When the State of Ohio sends to the Village its monies for the Litter Grant, the first \$3,000.00 shall be placed into the General Fund.

Section 3: This resolution shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
