

RESOLUTION NUMBER 86-08

A RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY FOR LEVY IN EXCESS OF TEN MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Village Council of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 18th day of February, 1986, at the office of the Village with the following members present:

Mr. Kate Matts moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Buckeye Lake for the purpose of providing for current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding 5 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 5 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years and which levy is a new levy of five mills.

Resolved, that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Buckeye Lake at the primary election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Buckeye Lake on the 18th day of February, 1986; and be it further

Resolved, that said levy be extended on the tax list of the Village of Buckeye Lake if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

Resolved, that the Clerk of this Village be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Licking County, Ohio, as provided by law, and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

This Resolution shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law since its passage is necessary to protect the health and safety of the village residents.
