A RESOLUTION DECLARING TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF TEN MILL LIMITATION.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, County of Licking and State of Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, for the purpose of providing for the current expenses of the Village at a rate not exceeding five mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five years.

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed on the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Village be and hereby is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Licking County, Ohio, within seventy-five (75) days of passage and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
