A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN VILLAGE STREETS FOR REPAVING AND RESURFACING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK/TREASURER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE REPAVING AND RESURFACING OF SAID STREETS.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has previously advertised for bids for the repaving of certain streets; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accomplish the repaving/resurfacing during 1986;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The following streets are to be repaved according to the bid specifications on file in the Clerk's Office:

1. Seamore Street in Myers Addition
2. Lake Street (the last block going North)
3. Woods Avenue in Myers Addition
4. Linwood to Eastlandwood
5. Cliff Street to Smith Street
6. Church Street to the curve
7. Cross over on State Route 79 to 6th Avenue

Section 2: The Shelly Company is hereby declared to be the best bidder and their bid for the street repaving/resurfacing project is hereby accepted.

Section 3: The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into contract with the Shelly Company on behalf of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio for the repaving/resurfacing of said streets.

Section 4: The sum of \$20,330.75 is hereby authorized for expenditure on said street repaving/resurfacing contract.

Section 5: This Resolution shall go into immediate effect since an emergency exists because of the short period of time remaining for resurfacing of streets to be accomplished before inclement weather occurs.

CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify the above to be an accurate account of the action of Council on the above matter.

CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 6th day of October, 1986, by and between the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, hereinafter "Village", and the Shelly Company, hereinafter "Company".

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for the repaving/resurfacing of certain Village streets.

For the mutual covenants hereinafter provided, the parties agree as follows:

1. Company agrees to repave/resurface the following streets according to the specifications on file in the Village clerk's office:

Seamore Street in Myers Addition
Lake Street (the last block going North)
Woods Avenue in Myers Addition
Linwood to Eastlandwood
Cliff Street to Smith Street
Church Street to the curve
Cross over on State Route 79 to 6th Avenue

2. Company agrees to perform all work in a workmanlike manner.

3. Company agrees to notify the Village twenty-four (24) hours prior to commencement of the project so traffic can be rerouted and parked vehicles moved.

4. Company agrees to provide workers' compensation insurance for all employees participating in this project.

5. Village agrees to compensate Company in the amount of \$ 29330.25 within thirty (30) days of completion of this project.

6. Village agrees to cooperate fully with Company in paragraph three (3) above.

7. Each party understands that additional monies in excess of this contract shall be provided only after the receipt of a duly executed purchase order.
