

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE  
LICKING COUNTY, OHIO

RESOLUTION NUMBER 90-02 TO DECLARE THE DESIRABILITY OF HAVING CONSTRUCTED CANALS AND OTHER RECREATIONAL FACILITIES ON THE LAND LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE AS WELL AS ON THE LANDS CONTIGUOUS TO THE VILLAGE AS PROPOSED IN THE DEVELOPMENT PLANS OF JEAN AND HELMUTH ENGELMAN, JAMES AND CHRISTINE COOPER, AND LIV-HI COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the future economic and social growth of Buckeye Lake is directly related to the intelligent development of the lands within the boundaries of Buckeye Lake as well as those lands lying immediately adjacent thereto; and

WHEREAS, intelligent growth entails development of the natural resources in an ecologically sensitive manner utilizing the waters of Buckeye Lake in harmony with sensible growth of residential and commercial facilities; and

WHEREAS, plans submitted by the foregoing property owners make such an intelligent allocation of the resources of the Village and the State, and

WHEREAS, the refusal to permit construction of the canals would only contribute to pressures to have such vital resources haphazardly developed in a piecemeal fashion and in a manner which does not protect the natural shoreline of Maple Bay nor protect the Blue Heron rookery, the majority of which are located upon private real estate, and which are protected by the submitted plan; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village that the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, is arbitrarily withholding the issuing of the permits for the construction of certain canals which have been approved by the Department of Army, Corp of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, the construction of such canals would promote the use of the Buckeye Lake State Park and otherwise confer recreational benefits on the general public; Now Therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE:

That this Council does hereby declare and resolve that the construction of canals as proposed in the development plans of Jean and Helmuth Engelman, James and Christine Cooper, and Liv-Hi Company be recognized as an intelligent ecologically sensitive plan that furthers the recreational aspects of the natural resources of the Park and waters of Buckeye Lake and as an intelligent and desirable plan of development which furthers the economic and social development of both the Village of Buckeye Lake and the State of Ohio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be presented to the Hearing Officer hearing the appeal of the property owners on their application for a permit to construct such canals demonstrating the support of council for issuance of the canal permits, and further, that this resolution act as a legislative finding of fact of the council of Buckeye Lake that construction pursuant to the plans as submitted will be advantageous to the Division of Parks in promoting increased recreational activities in the area.
