

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-07

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is planning to make emergency repairs to Park St. retaining wall, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be an Emergency need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC emergency programs,

NOW THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, County of Licking, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION II: The Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements that are necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION III: In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye lake in that application for funding for the proposed project is due immediately need to submit application and secure funding of July 1, 2021 this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
